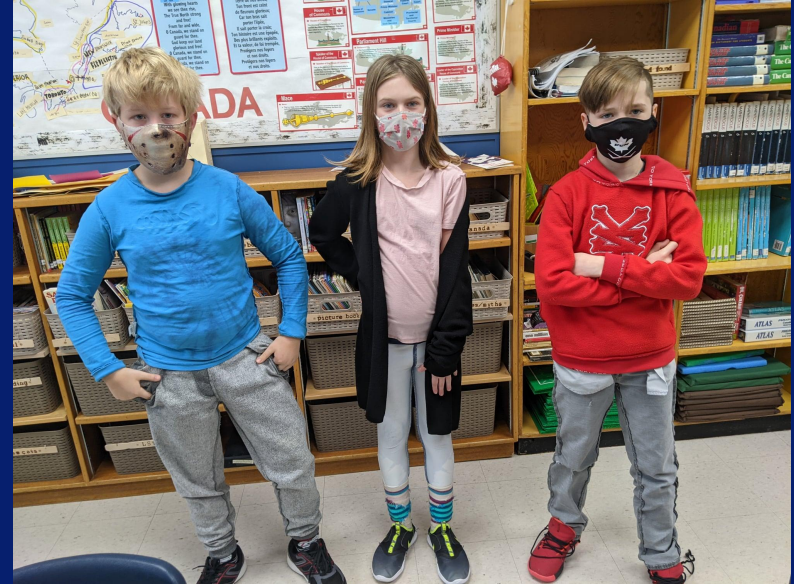
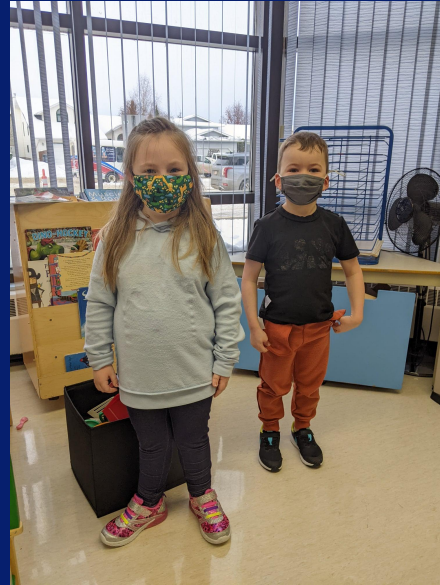
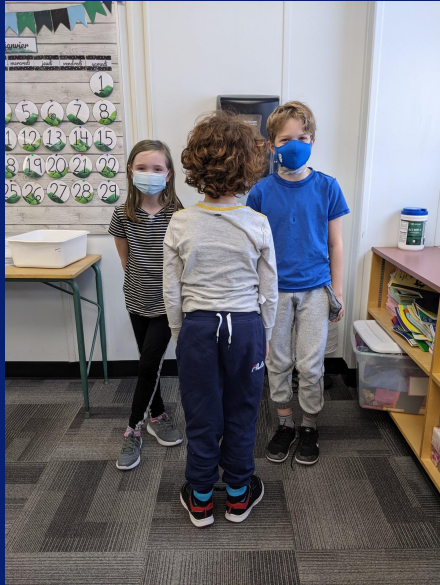

Students at École Bellevue School enjoyed the nice weather and dropped some donations off at the Karma Pantry.



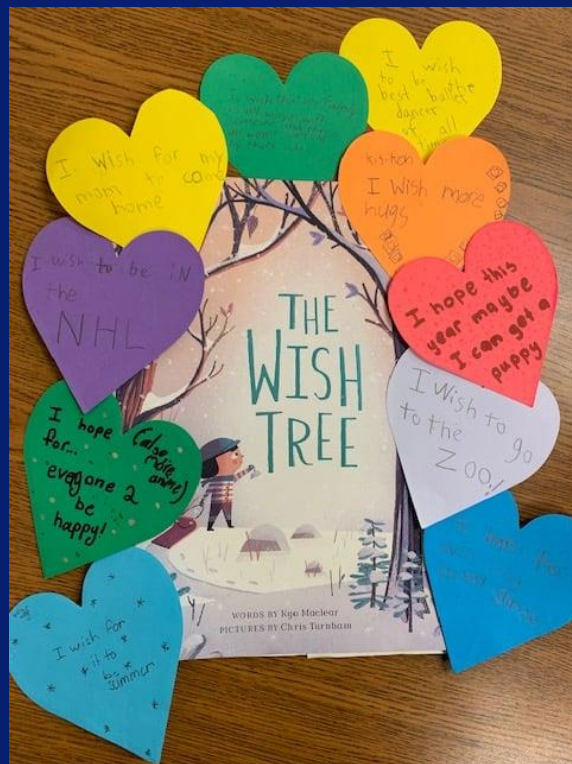
Check out these amazing creations from the construction class at John Maland High School!



At Willow Park School, the Grade 5 Science class built circuits and tinkered with Little Bits as part of their study of electricity.



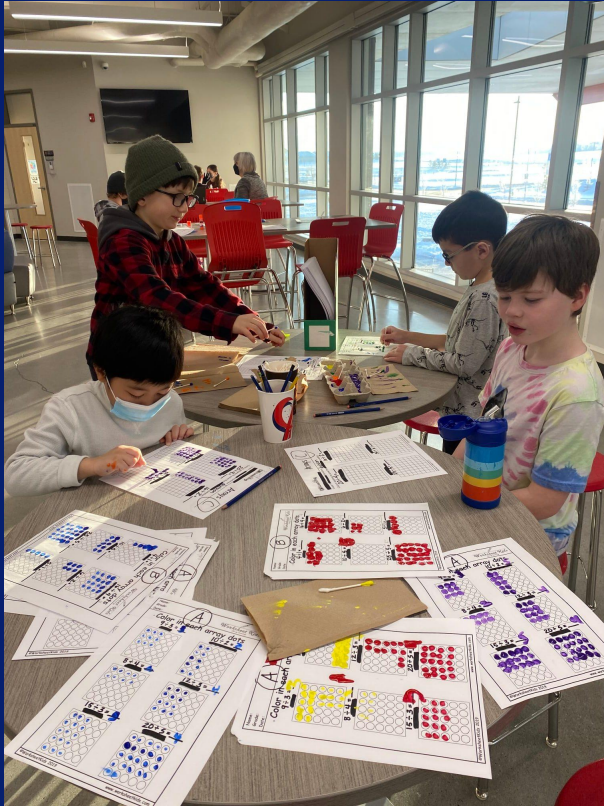

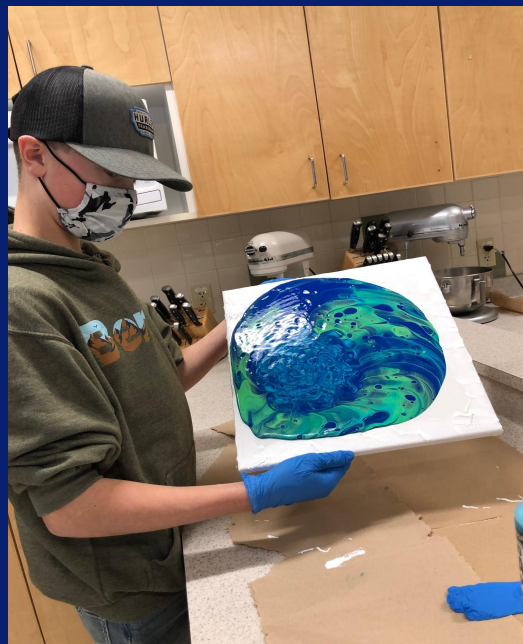

The Riverview Middle School leadership students planned an "Alien Day" on January 20. Mr. Law even pulled out his best suit - he looked out of this world!



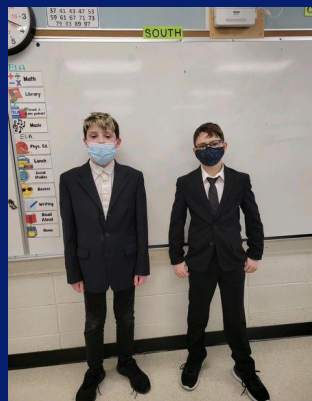
At École Coloniale Estates School, the Grade 2 students recently enjoyed a Buoyancy and Boats “field trip.”
