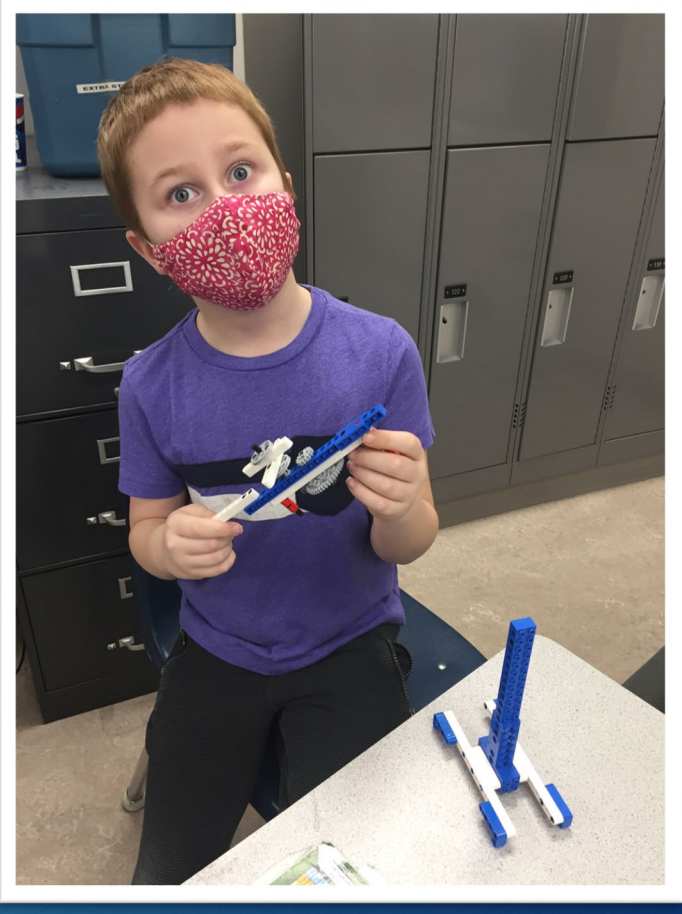
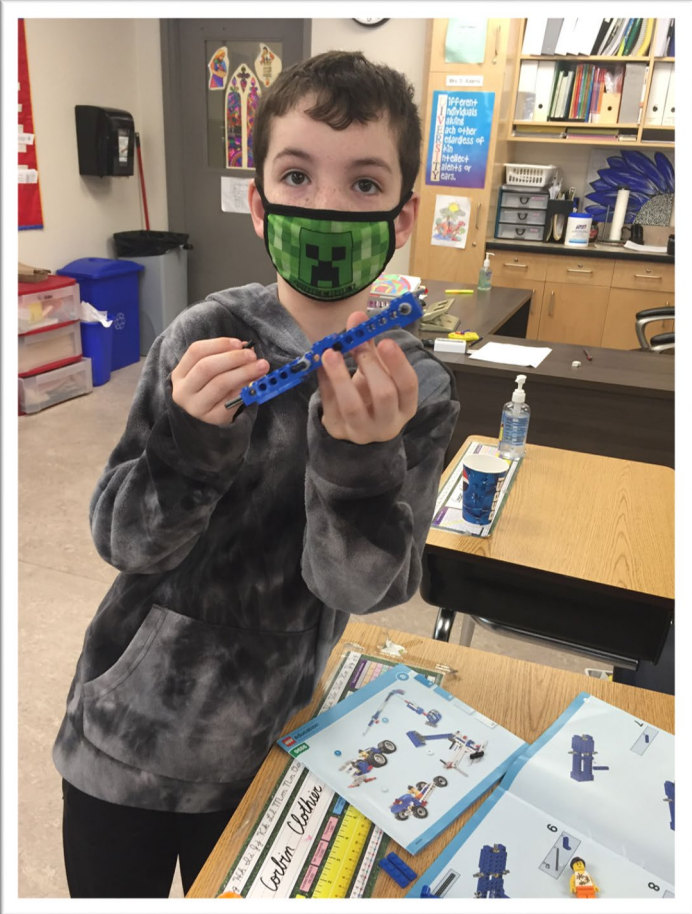
Warburg School staff and students had a lot of fun celebrating Crazy/Fancy Hair Day.

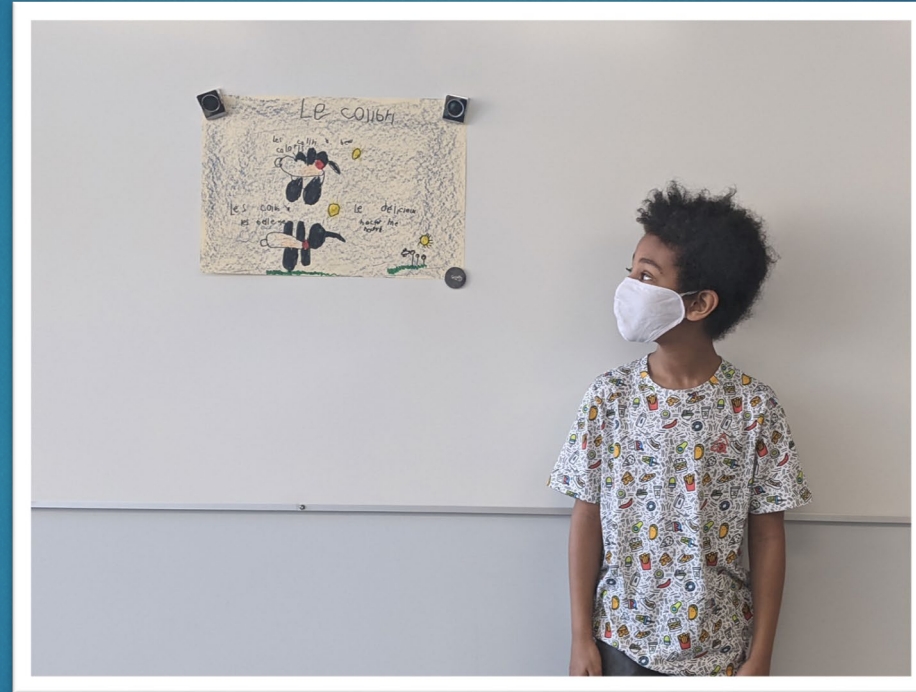


Mrs. Adams' Grade 4 class at Caledonia Park class enjoyed some lego (STEM) builds to coordinate with their Building Devices Unit.





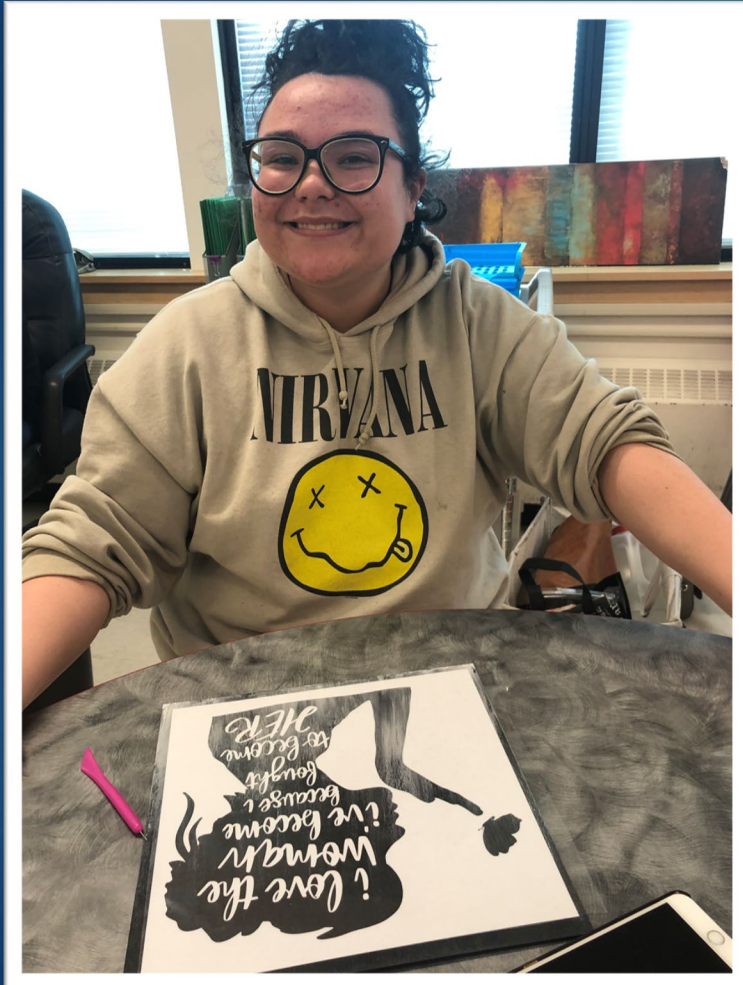

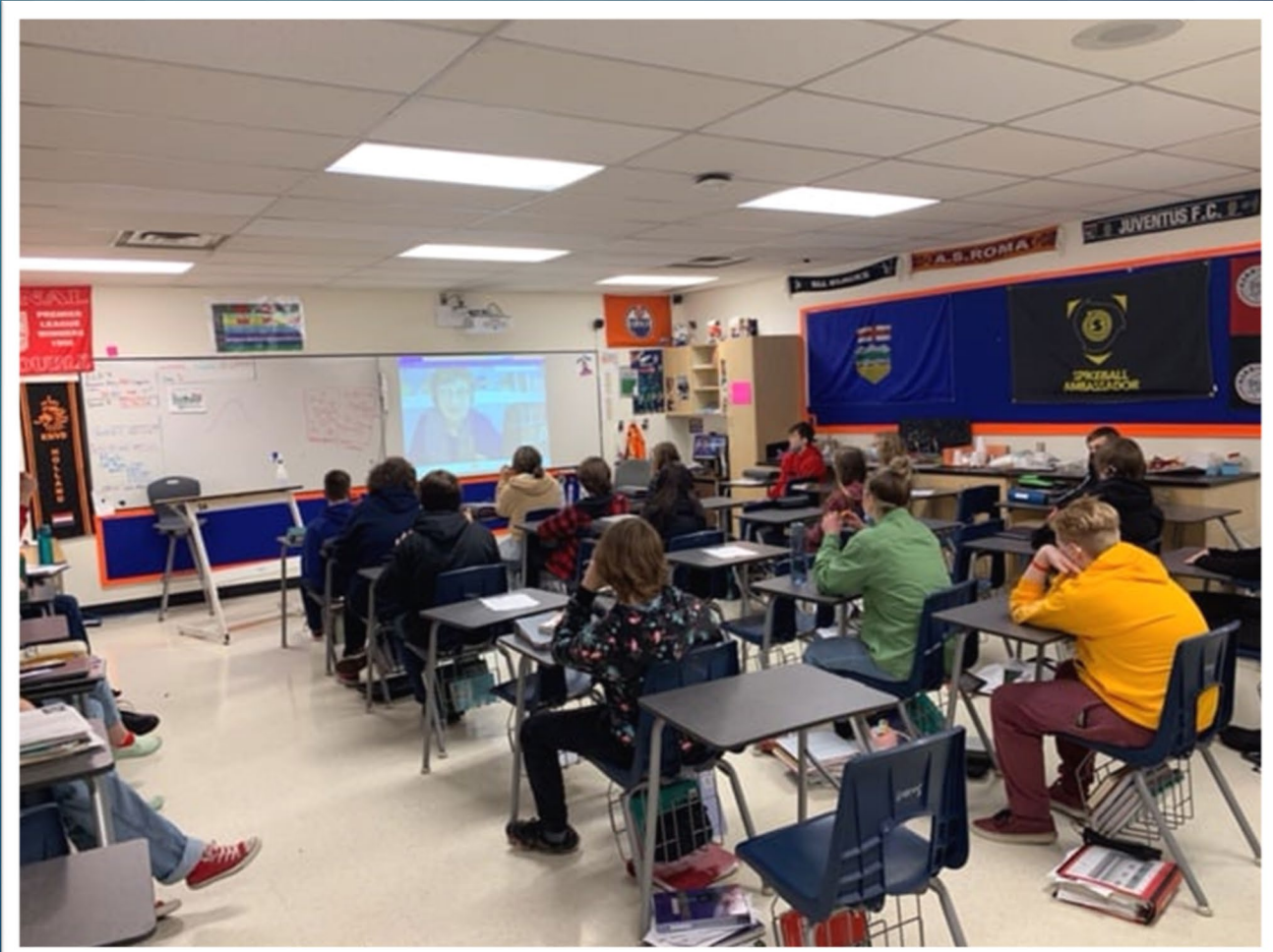
Black Gold's Mental Health Capacity Building program promotes empowering girls and women through a weekly group of cohorted students at Thorsby Junior/Senior High School.
