- For students experiencing difficulty in regular grades 8 to 12 programs, the Division supports
 the implementation of Knowledge and Employability (K & E) Courses of study designed to
 develop student workplace skills while supporting continued growth in core academic
 subjects.
- 2. K & E courses may be offered in grades 8 12 schools where numbers warrant and where students and parents are informed about the nature and intent of the coursework.
- 3. Before a student may be enrolled in a K & E course or program, a K & E Course(s) Consent form must be completed and signed by the parents, student, and Principal and placed in the Student Records. A copy of the form will be forwarded to the Director of Student Services.
- 4. All K & E programs must meet the requirements for students to earn a Certificate of Completion as stated in the Guide to Education.
